Dear Sir/Madam,

In terms of the revised Articles of Association of the Company as approved by the Shareholders through Postal Ballot, our promoters, (a) GAIL (India) Limited ("GAIL") has nominated Mr. Bhuwan Chandra Tripathi, Chairman and Managing Director, GAIL as the Chairman and Non-Executive Director of Mahanagar Gas Limited and (b) BG Asia Pacific Holdings Pte. Limited ("BGAPH") has withdrawn the nomination, of Mr. Goutam Ghosh, Whole Time Director designated as Technical Director and of Mr. Akhil Mehrotra as Chairman of MGL. However, Mr. Akhil Mehrotra shall continue to act as Non-Executive Director, nominee of BGAPH on the Board of MGL.

Accordingly, the Board of Directors in its meeting held today i.e November 28, 2018 inter alia transacted the following business:

i. Approved appointment of Mr. Bhuwan Chandra Tripathi, Chairman and Managing Director, GAIL as an Additional Director (Non-Executive & Non Independent) and Chairman of the Company effective from November 29, 2018.

Consequently, Mr. Akhil Mehrotra shall cease to be Chairman of MGL effective from the close of business hours of November 28, 2018. However, he will continue to act as Non-Executive Director of the Company.

Mr. Tripathi is not related to any Director on the Board of the Company. He is not debarred from holding the office of Director by virtue of any Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) order or any other such authority. The brief profile of Mr. Tripathi is enclosed herewith as *Annexure-I*.





- ii. Noted and approved the resignation of Mr. Ashu Shinghal, GAIL Nominee, Non-Executive Director on the Board of the Company due to official exigencies, with effect from close of business hours of November 28, 2018.
- iii. Noted and approved the resignation of Mr. Goutam Ghosh, Whole Time Director (designated as Technical Director) of the Company on account of withdrawal of nomination by BGAPH with effect from close of business hours on November 28, 2018.

The Board Meeting commenced at 1800 hrs and concluded at 1930 hrs.

Annexure-I

Brief Profile of Mr. Bhuwan Chandra Tripathi

Mr. Bhuwan Chandra Tripathi is Chairman and Managing Director of GAIL (India) Limited ("GAIL") since August 1, 2009 and has been a member of the Board of Directors of GAIL since July 2007. Under his leadership and sustained efforts, GAIL ranks amongst the Top 10 international LNG portfolio players and also stands elevated to the stature of a 'Maharatna' public sector enterprise.

GAIL has strengthened its core businesses across natural gas midstream and downstream chains during the last decade by doubling gas transmission capacity, tripling petrochemicals marketable portfolio and has also forayed into newer game-changing opportunities by securing over 8.0 MTPA long-term LNG from diversified geographies, spread on multiple indexes for supporting India's energy security.
